



Randell K. Wood is the founding partner in the law firm of Wood & Associates, LLP. A trial lawyer with a particular emphasis on international issues, Randell Wood has brought significant product liability actions on behalf of injured consumers against foreign corporations, negotiated international prisoner exchanges

between countries, and been called upon to represent foreign nations before United States courts and tribunals.

His cases are often controversial, and have included litigation involving international financial frauds, federal criminal conspiracy trials, and compliance with anti-terrorism financial regulations and United Nation resolutions. He has been asked by nations to assist in cross-border, multi-jurisdictional asset recovery, and repatriating of the proceeds of corruption, including use of the United Nations Convention against Corruption (UNCAC). Early in his practice he worked as a prosecutor for the City of Springfield and served at judicial appointment as the special prosecutor for the 39th Judicial Circuit.

In addition to his advocacy work, Randell Wood has lectured and authored articles on product liability, international relations, 4th amendment rights, ethics, and criminal practice. When not practicing law he enjoys restoring classic automobiles and is an avid reader of fiction.

He attended College of the Ozarks from 1969 to 1971 and received his Bachelor of Science from Southwest Missouri State University in 1975 with a major in Psychology and minors in Philosophy, Religion and Mathematics. He attended Graduate School at Southwest Missouri State University from 1975 to 1976 studying Counseling Psychology. Mr. Wood then went on to receive his Juris Doctorate from the University of Missouri at Kansas City

in 1979. Before founding the law firm of Wood and Associates, he worked as the Springfield City Prosecutor and at judicial request as the Special Prosecutor for the 39th Judicial Circuit. Mr. Wood is currently admitted to practice law before the United States Supreme Court, the Missouri Supreme Court, the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit, and the United States District Courts for the Eastern and Western Districts of Missouri. Mr. Wood is also a member of the Missouri Bar, the Association of Trial Lawyers of America, the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, the International Bar Association, the Springfield Metropolitan Bar Association and the Missouri Association of Trial Attorneys. Over the years Mr. Wood has lectured on issues ranging from product liability, search and seizure, 4th amendment rights, probable cause, ethics, and criminal practice. He has also authored numerous legal articles. His areas of practice include; personal injury, litigation, civil and criminal trials, product liability litigation, international law, prison transfer treaties and major felony drug cases.
